Ordinance No. 03-10

Passed March 22, 2010

AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE MORATORIUM UNTIL JUNE 30, 2010 ON PORTIONS OF SECTIONS 1175.06 AND 1175.07 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCE RELATING TO TEMPORARY SIGNS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, certain subsections of Section 1175.06 of the Codified Ordinances set forth standards on the number of, setbacks for, and permit requirements for temporary signs; and,

WHEREAS, certain other subsections of Section 1175.07 of the Codified Ordinances set forth standards for banner signs; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 28-09, Village Council placed a temporary moratorium on the effectiveness and application of the aforementioned standards regarding temporary signs and banner signs; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance 36-09 extended the moratorium until March 31, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission held a public hearing on February 10, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, Village Council desires to extend the moratorium until June 30, 2010, to allow review and consideration of proposed revisions to the sign code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Obetz, County of Franklin, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Council for the Village of Obetz hereby extends the moratorium on the effectiveness and application of the following subsections of Sections 1175.06 and 1175.07 of the Codified Ordinances regarding temporary signs and banner signs:

Section 1175.06(a)(2)	Section 1175.07(c)(1)
Section 1175.06(b)(3)	Section 1175.07(c)(2)
Section 1175.06(b)(5)	Section 1175.07(c)(3)
Section 1175.06(b)(8)	

Section 2. The temporary moratorium will expire on June 30, 2010, unless further extended by Village Council by ordinance.

Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

Section 4. Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that the Village desires to immediately revisit and evaluate its temporary sign permit regulations; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.


